P R E F A C E

The present publication which is the 7th in the series features the most recent national accounts of Sri Lanka for the period 1975-1982, as prepared by the Department of Census and Statistics. Much of the material published in the Bulletin, was made available in the earlier publication in the form of actual estimates upto 1981, and a set of 'quick estimates' for 1982 which were prepared for the first time by the Department.

Further progress has been made since then in preparing many new accounts in order to set up an integrated system of national accounts. These include an income and outlay account and a capital finance account for the government sector for the period 1977-1980, and a household sector account for 1982. These sectoral accounts represent an important advance made by the Department to fulfil a long felt need for establishing an integrated system of accounts for the country.

It is also important to mention here that a Supply and Disposition Account covering the Agricultural Sector for the year 1982 has been included in this publication for the first time. All these additional accounts have been prepared with the use of the most recent data available from sources such as the Labour Force and Socio-Economic Survey of 1981 and Highland Crops and Livestock Survey 1980. The new accounts are all provisional, and will be further improved as the data become available.

Detailed estimates of the expenditure totals of Private Consumption and Capital Formation have again been included in this publication for a series of years according to International Comparison Project Categories.

Meanwhile considerable progress has also been made in the preparation of an Input Output Table, for the year 1981, and this will be released in a few months.

The work of improvement will continue in order to cover the gaps and discontinuities in the accounts that have been introduced for the first time. By introducing these new accounts an initial attempt has been made in establishing an integrated system of accounts but the fuller elaboration of national product statistics requires a further development of Sri Lanka's Economic Statistics particularly the statistics on income as distinct from those on production and expenditure.

It is hoped that the present publication which includes many important accounts, will continue to provide a useful guide to planners and policy makers.

The present estimates have been prepared with the advise and guidance of Mr. W.S.M. Fernando, Deputy Director and Mrs. D.S.L. Weeratunga, Assistant Director and under the direction of Statisticians, Miss. G. N. de Silva, Messrs. D. Amarasinghe, A.P.G.S. de Silva and S. K. Lankatilleka, by the National Accounts Division of the Department of Census and Statistics.

G.D.P. BY INDUSTRIAL ORIGIN AT (1975) CONSTANT PRICES

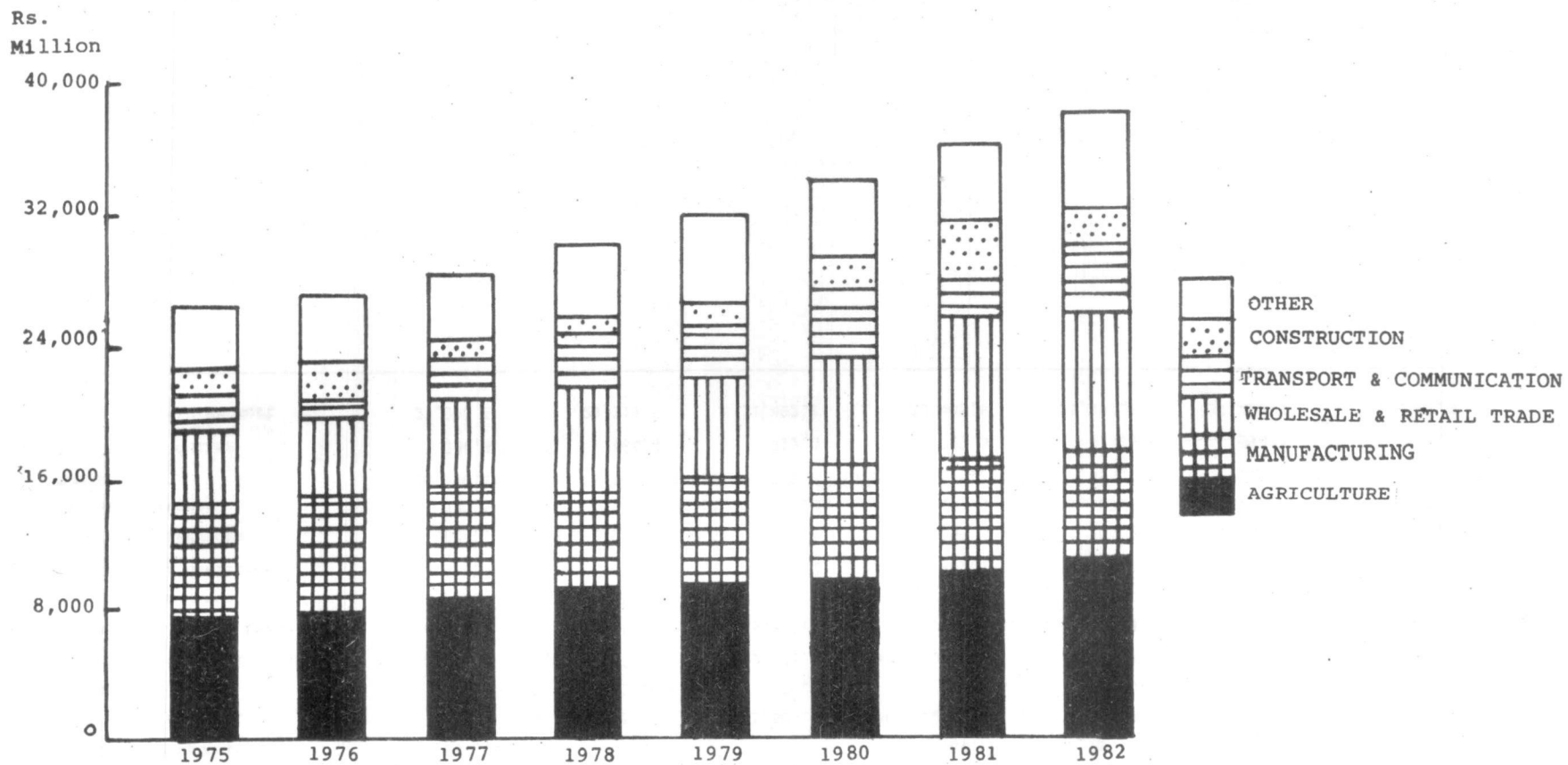

G.D.P. IN CURRENT & CONSTANT (1975) PRICES

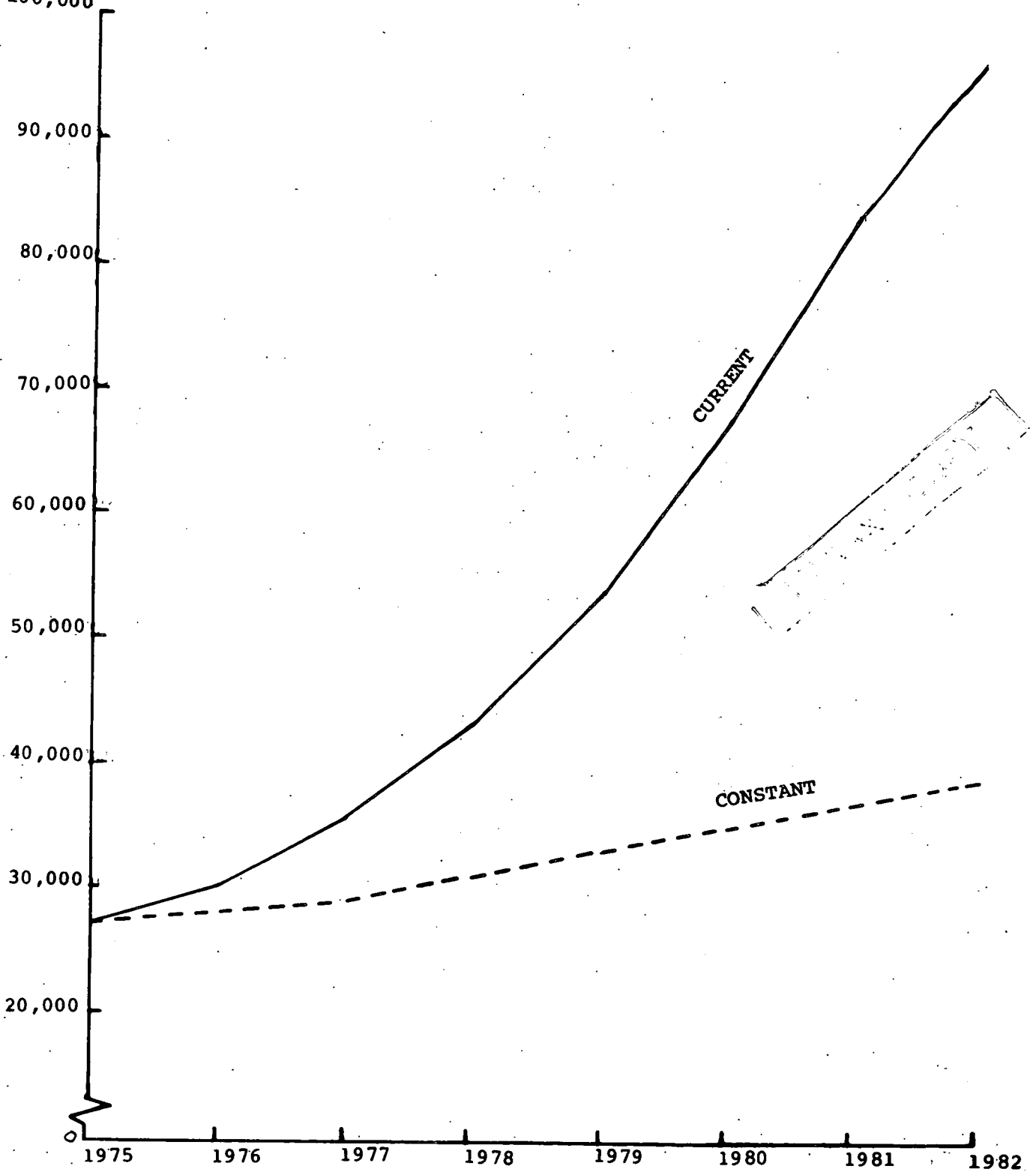


CHART 3

G.D.P. PER CAPITA IN CURRENT & CONSTANT (1975) PRICES

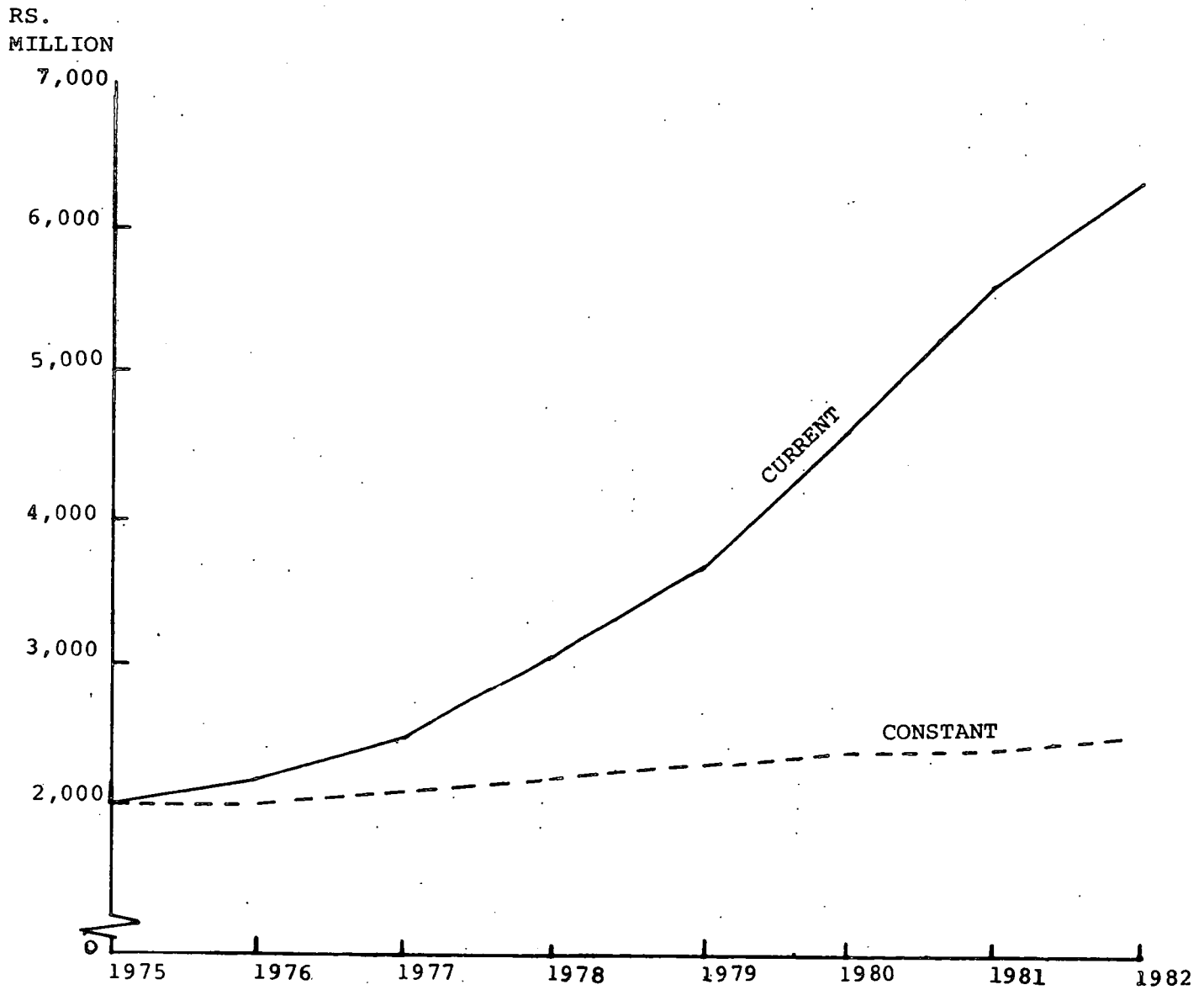

COMPOSITION OF AGRICULTURE IN G.D.P. AT CONSTANT (1975) PRICES

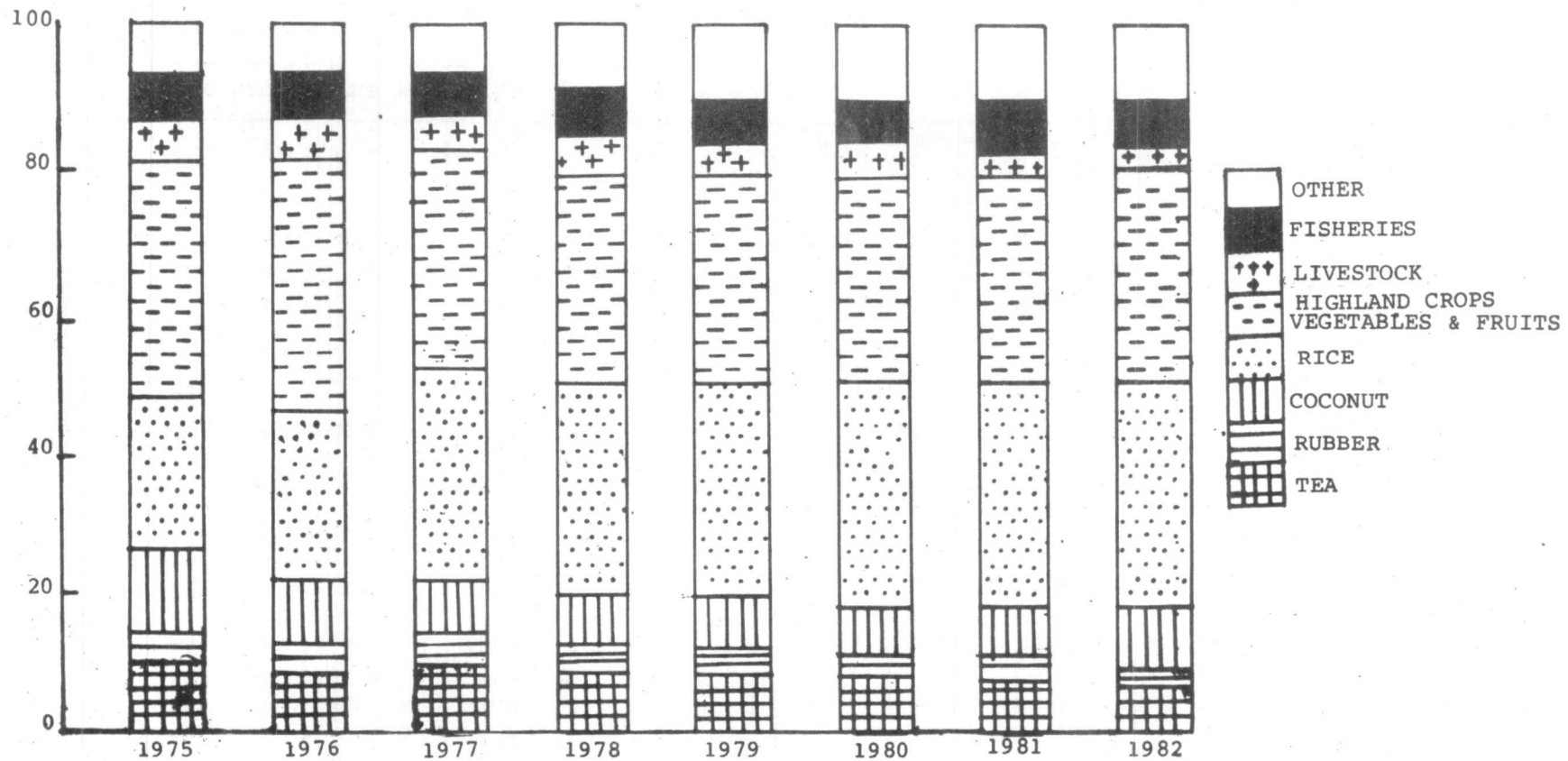

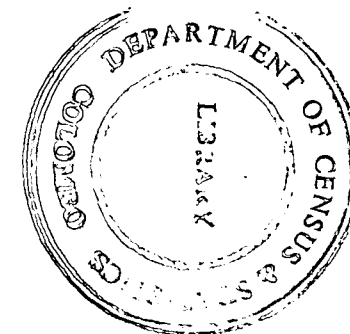

Scope of the Account:

The preparation of the Household and Unincorporated Sector Income and Outlay Accounts for 1981 and 1982 is the first such attempt made by the Department in the preparation of estimates for this sector. It shows the receipts and disposition of incomes which is directly linked with production accounts and the final consumption expenditure accounts for the system. Figures are provisional and will be revised when more refine data become available.

Receipts:

Item 1 & 2 : The estimates for item 1 & 2 are based on National Accounts and the Socio Economic and Labour Force Survey of 1980/1981. Value added net of depreciation has been distributed among these two items.

Item 3 : Current Transfers received have been obtained from the Insurance Corporation, Budgetary Records, Balance of Payments Accounts and Ad-hoc Studies.

Disbursements:

Item 1 : Final Consumption Expenditure is obtained from National Accounts.

Item 2 : Interest, Mortgage etc. estimated using co-efficients obtained from Surveys and other studies.

Item 3 : Direct taxes and other payments to government have been obtained from government accounts.

Item 4 : Except for transfers to private non-profit institutions serving households which has been estimated using the data from surveys and other records, the rest are based on direct sources such as the Insurance Corporation and Balance of Payments data.

Item 5 : Savings, represent, the balance of receipts over disbursements.
