

# Department of Census to conduct enterprise survey

**Survey to measure the economic impact caused by COVID 19**

The Department of Census and Statistics, being the main governmental statistical organization in Sri Lanka has initiated an enterprise survey, via a representative sample of more than 15000 entities, encompassing both the informal and formal sectors, to measure the economic impact caused by the COVID 19 pandemic to the Sri Lankan economy.

The world has been facing the largest economic crises which had ever faced due to COVID 19 pandemic, after the economic recession of the 1930s.

Under the globalized economy, many activities of the Sri Lankan economy have also been affected in

varying degrees by this pandemic, and as a result many economic activities of certain industries operated in Sri Lanka are in the verge of collapsing, posing threats to the thou-

sands of employees losing their jobs.

At this juncture, proper long term plans are to be formulated and implemented based on accurate and timely information immediately, to

support evidenced-based decision making of the country, to revive the partially collapsed or stagnated economy towards the economic prosperity and emancipation.
