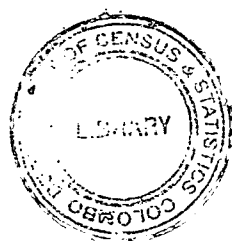



Definitions :

AGRICULTURAL LAND : Land under Paddy, Permanent Crops and Other Temporary Crops.

INLAND WATER : Sea, Lagoons, Tanks & Reservoirs and Major Rivers.

HOMESTEAD : Family residential units surrounded by homegardens and open spaces.

SPARSELY USED CROPLAND : Chena (shifting cultivation), recently abandoned chena, sparsely used rainfed cropland (permanent dry cropping), neglected or abandoned tea, rubber and coconut lands and land under development.

SCRUB LAND: Low growing vegetation with more than 50% area coverage, including trees with less than approx. 40% crown closure.

LAND UNDER FOREST : This includes Dense Forest, Open Forest, and Forest Plantations.

BUILT-UP LAND : Residential (including hotels), industrial, commercial, institutional, administrative, transportation, power plants and urban open spaces.

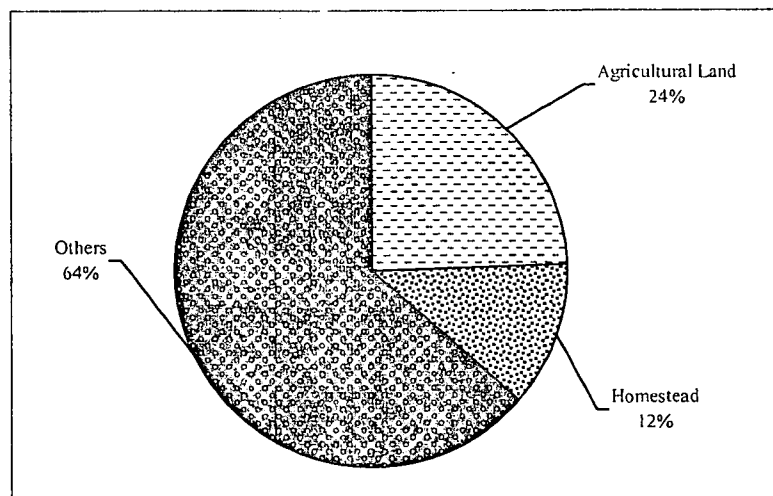

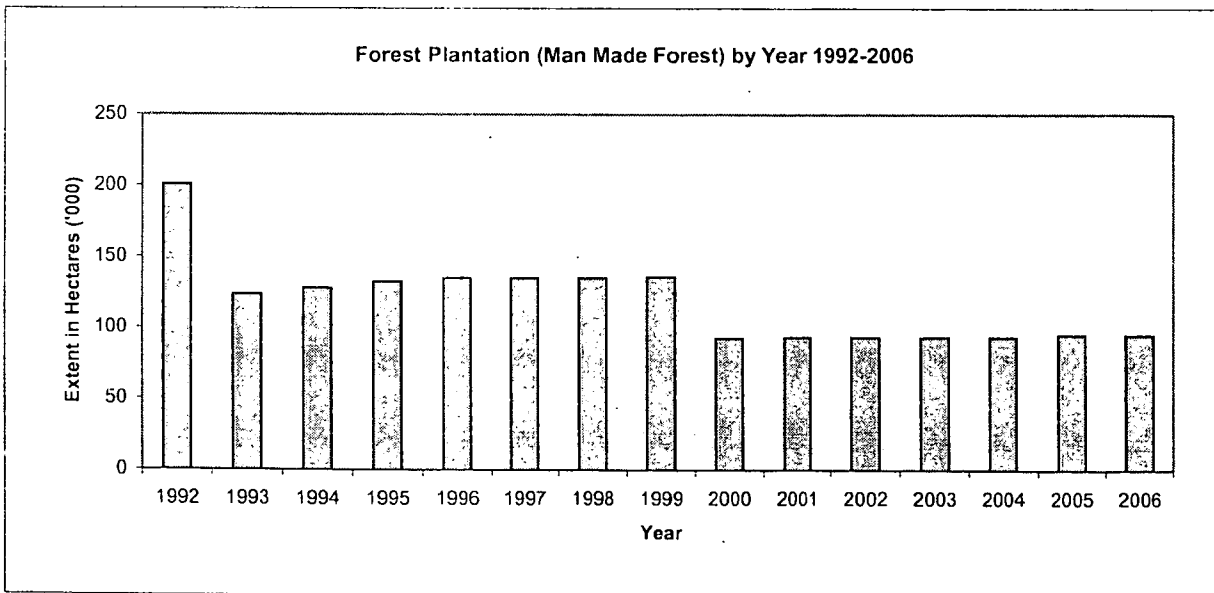
