Inflation decreases

Inflation, as measured by the Consumers' Price Index (CPI) (2006/07=100), computed by the Department of Census and Statistics, decreased on a year-on-year basis (YoY) to 6.4 per cent in September 2011 for the second consecutive month, from 7.0 per cent in August 2011. Meanwhile, the annual average inflation moved up marginally to 7.2 per cent in September from 7.1 per cent in the previous month, as a result of the price developments in the preceding twelve month period.
