PREFACE

A significant change in the planning process is taking place in several developing countries including Sri Lanka. The new approach envisages planning which commences at lower levels. Such an approach can succeed, however, only if a comprehensive data base is developed at lower levels.

The preparation of District Reports on the structure of agricultural holdings and their characteristics is one of the steps initiated by the Department of Census & Statistics to build up the required data base at the district level. The Report on Hambantota is the first in the series of such District Reports giving the main results of Census of Agriculture 1982.

With the completion of Census of Agriculture 1982, a complete frame of agricultural operators and agricultural holdings is available in the Department. This could be made use of for any future survey in the agricultural sector.

I am deeply grateful to the officers of the Department of Census & Statistics, the Government Agents and their staff, officers and officials of the Department of Agrarian Services for their assistance and to the farmers of Sri Lanka, who extended their fullest co-operation in conducting the Census and monitoring it to a successful conclusion.

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CHAPTER -

BACKGROUND

1.1 The Census of Agriculture & Livestock 1982, covered the entire Island excluding the municipal areas of Colombo and Dehiwala-Mt.Lavinia which are predominantly residential and commercial areas.

1.2. METHODOLOGY & ITEM COVERAGE

Agriculture in Sri Lanka is carried on in two distinct sectors viz: (i) the estate or the plantation sector and (ii) the peasant or the small holding sector. The Census of Agriculture covered both the sectors.

SMALL HOLDING SECTOR

FIRST STAGE

The Census was carried out in two stages. At the first stage the enumerators visited each and every census unit namely, housing unit, living quarters other-than housing units and non-housing units in the country and screened out the agricultural operators through a schedule known as AC 1. After identifying the agricultural operators, the enumerators collected the following information in respect of their operational holdings through the schedule AC 2.

- 1. Characteristics of the Operators Age, Sex and Educational Status.
- 2. Type of ownership of land.
- 3. Operational status of the operator.
- 4. Area of operational holding.
- 5. Area under principal crops.
- 6. Irrigated area and source.
- 7. Agricultural machinery.
- 8. Number of livestock.

SECOND STAGE

At the second stage a sample of 10% of the holdings have been selected and the following information was collected through the schedule AC 3.

- 1. Population of operator's household.
- 2. Sources of income of operator's household.
- 3. Main occupation of the operator.
- 4. Type of holding.
- 5. Use of fertilizer & pesticide.

6. Land utilization and tenurial pattern.

Two reports have been published so far in respect of the small holding sector. The first one is preliminary report based on the summary sheets furnished by the enumerator immediately after the field work. The second report is based on 10 percent sample tabulation and gives estimates on various characteristics of agricultural holdings. The present report which is based on 100 percent tabulation is one of the reports in the series of district reports proposed to be brought out.

ESTATE SECTOR

In the Agricultural Census, estate sector has been covered through a mailed questionnaire (AC 5). A set of questionnaires has been sent to all estates by the Commissioner of Census, asking the operators to complete and send these back. A detailed report on estate sector has already been published.

1.3 SOME CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

A number of concepts were followed for conducting the Agriculture Census. These concepts have been discussed in detail in the report on Small Holding Sector published in 1984. Some of the important concepts however have been given in this report.

AGRICULTURAL OPERATOR

An Agricultural Operator is the person responsible for operating the agricultural land and or livestock. He may carry out the agricultural operations by himself or with the assistance of others or simply direct day to day operations.

This means that a person may attend to all the work needed to cultivate the and or tend livestock but will not be considered the operator if there is someone else directing day to day work on the holding. It also means that a person may supervise the work in a holding appearing for all purposes to be in charge of the operations of the holding but if there is someone else who is giving day to day directions, he does not become the operator.

The operator may himself cultivate the land and/or tend the livestock. He may do so with the assistance of labour hired or otherwise he may not do any physical labour at all but only direct day to day operations on the holding. It is important to note that the operator need not necessarily be the owner of land or livestock and also that mere ownership does not entitle a person to be considered as an operator.

In respect of livestock, any person who is actually responsible for the management of livestock in the same way that a land operator is responsible for his holding will be considered the operator. The livestock may be owned, obtained on "Ande" or lease or any other form of arrangement. While most livestock operators will also be land operators, there would be cases of livestock operators who are not land operators and therefore have no land holdings. The term agricultural operator includes both land operator

as well as purely livestock or poultry operator.

While most of the operators have only one holding, there could be cases of an operator having more than one holding.

AGRICULTURAL HOLDING

An agricultural holding consists of all land and/or livestock used wholly or partly for agricultural production irrespective of title, size, legal form or location and is operated under one operational status.

This means that it does not matter whether the land is one parcel or is composed of more than one parcel, whether the parcels are scattered and where they are located, whether in the same G.S. Division or not.

This also means that it does not matter whether the land is owned or not, whether the land is legally operated or not.

The requirements for considering it as a holding is only that it should be under one management and under one operational status.

An agricultural holding may be a purely land holding, land and livestock holding or purely a livestock holding.

HOME GARDEN

- (a) A piece of land which has a dwelling house and having some form of cultivation can be considered as home garden if the total area of that piece of land is twenty or less than twenty perches.
- (b) A piece of land which has some form of cultivation, the total area of which is more than twenty perches can also be considered as home garden if the following two conditions are satisfied.
 - 1. It has a dwelling house.
 - 2. The produce of the cultivated land in the home garden is largely for home consumption.

"Having some form of cultivation" will mean any cultivation for agricultural production will include even one coconut palm or arecanut palm if they are not too old to bear, or a couple of chilly plants etc. However, flower plants, wild trees, unproductive bushes will not be treated as cultivation for agricultural production.

LAND OWNED

Land owned for the purpose of the census means both land legally owned which would be the land over which the holder possesses title of ownership and consequently the right to determine to what use it should be put to as well as the right for transfer and land held in ownerlike possession.

Land is said to be in ownerlike possession when the holder operates it in a ownerlike way even though he does not possess the title of ownership.

Some examples of ownerlike possession are:

- 1. Land operated under perpetual lease, hereditary tenure and under long term leases ranging from 30 to 40 years.
- 2. land without legal title of ownership nor of a long term lease, has been peacefully and uninterruptedly operated by the holder for a period of 30 years without payment of rent.
- 3. Land owned by wife but operated by the husband who also is the operator. This land is considered owned by the operator in ownerlike possession.

SMALL HOLDING

An agricultural holding of less than 20 acres and under the same operational status was considered as a small holding. In some cases however a holding might consist of several parcels and the total area of these add together to 20 acres and above, this holding is still considered a small holding.

ESTATE

An agricultural holding of 20 acres in extent or more and under the same operational status was considered as an "Estate". There could be instances where different parcels of a holding add up to 20 acres or more. This was not considered as an estate. An estate should have at least one parcel where extent is 20 acres or above. Similarly holdings such as paddy lands of 20 acres and over are not considered as estates.

REFERENCE PERIOD

For the structure of agricultural holdings the reference period is the year preceding 1.7.1982. For livestock the reference period is as on 1.7.1982.

CHAPTER - 2

A BRIEF REVIEW OF THE RESULTS

2.1 BACKGROUND

Hambantota, the largest administrative district (out of three districts) in the Southern Province is situated in the Southern Corner of the Island. It has a land area of 2,593 square kilometers (640,800 acres). The population according to 1981 Census is 424,085 out of which 215,778 are males and 208,307 are females resulting in a sex ratio of 104 males per 100 females. Its rank in terms of Population among the districts of the Island is 15 and the density is 164 persons per square kilometre. This District comprises of 4 electorates, 8 Assistant Government Agent Divisions, 168 Grama Sevaka Divisions and 1,012 villages.

2.2 The distribution of the population by age groups and sex is given in Table 2.1.

Census of Population & Housing 1981.

Nearly sixty percent of the population is below 24 years of age. This district is mainly rural in character with 90 percent of its population living in rural areas. The district has an average annual rainfall of 1,075 m.m. and the average annual temperature is about 27 centigrades.

This District mainly falls into the dry zone, although some areas of the District are boardering the wet zone.

2.3 The population aged ten years and over by type of activity and sex in the District on the basis of 10 percent sample tabulation of the Census of Population and Housing 1981 is given in Table 2.2

The activity rate (ie. percentage of population aged 10 years and over in labour force to the total population) works out to 42.4 (67.0 for males and 16.4 females), against Island activity rate of 44.4 (65.4 for males and 22.5 for females).

2.4. About sixty one percent of the employed population is in Agriculture and allied sectors.

NUMBER OF OPERATORS AND AREA OPERATED

2.5 The number of Agricultural operators and area operated by A.G.A. Division wise is given in Table 2.3. The detailed analysis of the data pertaining to Estate Sector has been discussed separately in the Report on Estate Sector published in March 1984. However important data of Estate Sector of this District are given in annexure I. The present report deals with the analysis of data of small holding sector only.

Only 28 percent of the land area is cultivated. The percentage of operated area to total land area varies from 7.8 percent in Tissamaharama A.G.A. Division to 74.4 percent in Beliatta A.G.A. Division.

STRUCTURE OF AGRICULTURAL HOLDINGS

2.6 The distribution of the number and area of holdings in the District is given in table 2.4.

The average size of the holding in Hambantota is 2.45 acres as compared to Islands average of 1.94 acres. Nearly 24 percent of the holdings are less than 1 acre although they account for only 5 percent of the operated area. Forty seven per cent of the holdings are in the size group of 1 to 3 acres and they cover 32 percent of the area.

AGRICULTURAL OPERATORS BY AGE AND SEX

2.7 Forty two percent of the operators are in the age group of 25 to 44 years. Another 23 percent are in the age group of 45 to 54 (Table 2.5).

Only seventeen percent of the operators are females.

AGRICULTURAL OPERATORS BY EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

2.8 Twenty percent of the operators in Hambantota District fall in the category of No schooling. (Table 2.6).

AREA OWNED

2.9 Twenty two percent of the operators in the District did not own any land. Another thirty percent owned only a home garden.

OPERATIONAL STATUS

2.10 In ninety nine percent of the operational holdings, the status of the operators was on own account (Table 2.8)

CATEGORIES OF HOLDINGS

2.11 For tabulation purposes holdings were classified into three broad categories viz. Holdings with crops and livestock, holdings with crops only, holdings with livestock only. The number of such holdings along with the area under these three categories of holdings are given in Table 2.9

Eighty percent of the Agricultural holdings in the District are only Crop holdings and do not have any livestock.

- 2.12 To get the complete picture of the holding information on the area of the holding was collected separately for the following.
 - (a) Home garden
 - (b) Other highlands owned and cultivated by the operators.
 - (c) Other highlands owned by others but cultivated by the operators.
 - (d) Paddy lands owned and cultivated by the operators.
 - (e) Paddy lands owned by others but cultivated by the operators.

The number of holdings reporting the above categories and area under each category are given in Table 2.10

Twenty two percent of the operated area in the District is under home gardens. The area under category 3 and 5 can broadly be taken as area taken on rent. Twenty Eight percent of the land does not belong to operators and this can be treated as tenanted area.

2.13 Table 2.11 gives data on holdings having only homegardens or only highland or only paddy.

Fifty seven percent of the holdings in the District are one type holdings ie. having only home gardens or highlands only or paddy lands only.

PADDY HOLDINGS BY TYPE OF OWNERSHIP

2.14 Nearly 35 percent of the total holdings in the District reported some area under paddy. Out of 23,325 holdings reporting paddy, fifty three percent of the holdings had paddy which was owned and cultivated by the operators themselves. (Table 2.12)

Forty one percent of the area under paddy in Hambantota District was cultivated by operators who did not own these lands.

The average size of the paddy holding in Hambantota is 2.2 acres as compared to Islands average of 1.65 acres. Nearly one fourth of the paddy holdings in the District are below one acre in size.

LIVESTOCK

- 2.16 The Census of Agriculture provided an appurtunity to enumerate the number of livestock by sex, type and purpose. The information was collected and tabulated in respect of the following items.
 - 1. Number of cattle by type, age and sex.
 - 2. Distribution of the number of cattle by type, age and sex.
 - 3. Number of cattle of age 3 years and over by type, purpose and sex.
 - 4. Distribution of the number of cattle of age 3 years and over by type, purpose and sex.
 - 5. Number of Buffaloes by type, age and sex.
 - 6. Distribution of the number of buffaloes by type, age and sex.
 - 7. Number of Buffaloes of age-3 years and over by type, purpose and sex.
 - 8. Distribution of the number of Buffaloes of age 3 years and over by type purpose and sex.
 - 9. Number of Goats, Sheep and Pigs by age groups.
 - 10. Distribution of the number of Goats, Sheep and Pigs.
 - 11. Number of Poultry by type.
 - 12. Distribution of the number of Poultry.

CATTLE

2.17 At the time of enumeration there were nearly 53,000 Cattle in the District out of which 32% were males and 68% were females. Nearly 98% of the Cattle were of local bred only. (Table 2.14)

The age composition shows that 36 percent of the Cattle were below 3 years of age.

BUFFALOES

2.18 The total number of buffaloes in the District at the time of enumeration was 27,054 out of which thirty seven percent were males. (Table 2.15).

Six percent of the buffaloes in the District were either crossbred or highbred. The age composition shows that 67 percent of the buffaloes were three years and over.

LIMITATIONS OF DATA

2.19 The statistical tables given in this report are based on residence of the operators only. It means that the tabulation is based on the information collected from the agricultural operators residing in this district. (open segment concept - Enumeration of operators residing with in the boundary). The areas under crops are not given in this report since there may be agricultural lands in the district which are operated by the operators residing in adjoining districts or elsewhere. Therefore the data relating these areas would be available only when 100 percent tabulation is done in respect of all the districts in the Island. However the data users interested in crop areas could make use of the estimates given in the Report on Small holdings Sector based on 10 percent sample tabulation.
