



The drop is attributed to the sharp fall in rural sector poverty. Further, the 2009/10 survey indicated a two-third fall in poverty in the estate sector as a result of the drop in relative prices of food items.

Discussing Lanka tourism, Ruwankumar said that 9,000 direct employees may be needed per annum for the hotel sector, versus the current 1,500 yearly output of industry graduates.
